## What is SEOS?



SEOS – Sinu Elu, Otsustad Sina! (Your Life You Decide), is an organisation committed to communicating with students about issues ranging from sex and values to addictions and HIV/AIDS prevention, whilst making Jesus known to them. We aim to empower young people to make good decisions for their lives. The vision of SEOS is to bring the hope of the Gospel to at risk you as many as 500 – 600 schools in Estonia.

**SEOS** lets young people know they are supported and encouraged in their determination to behave in ways that resist the temptations of society, seeing sexual activity as an expression of permanent commitment, rather than as a recreational pastime.

**SEOS** was established in September 2010 in Partnership with Scripture Union Estonia and Love for Life (Northen Ireland).





### What do we do and how do we do it?

SEOS currently has three programmes through which we conduct lectures in schools, youth clubs and churches covering three main themes: Sex and Relationships, Addiction and Self-image.

The majority of our work is done through the state school system. We have developed partnerships with schools through which we teach lessons in the normal flow of the school day. All of our lessons are tightly integrated with the Estonian National Curriculum, providing teachers with a solid foundation on which to build aspects of their PSHE & Citizenship curriculum. Currently we are developing new lessons covering the topics of abuse and human trafficking, both of which desperately need to be discussed with the young people of Estonia.

We have recently been invited to work with youth centres. This is an exciting new area for us and gives us further opportunity to speak to young people. These talks require a more relaxed and flexible approach than lessons in schools, but also provide a more natural opportunity for deeper discussion with young people.

Finally, we are available to speak to church youth groups. There is a great need to inform youth and adults in the church about the problems facing our young people. These can be uncomfortable conversations for adults to have with young people, but they are nonetheless necessary. For example, statistics show us that, on average, children first view pornography on the internet at 12 years old. Therefore, SEOS is also committed to finding ways to minister to young people in the church.

We aim to be an organisation that uses young people to speak to young people on a peer level, but we also see the enormous value in using older, more experienced staff and volunteers.

### Why is this important?

Estonia is routinely found at the top of European rankings for various life restricting practices and lifestyle choices. These include teenage pregnancy, abortion, sexually transmitted infections, teenage suicide, bullying, divorce and alcohol consumption.

Our research shows that 30% of 11–16 year olds and 59% of 16–19 year olds are repeatedly under the influence of alcohol. Furthermore, 10% of 11-16 year olds and 20% of 16–19 year olds are regular drug users.

SEOS sees it as our mission and responsibility to bring the light of the gospel to our young people.

### The mission of SEOS:

SEOS creates communities of young people who value themselves and others, therefore resisting damaging behaviours and addictions, leading to the building and maintaining of healthy relationships.

SEOS provides young people with the information, skills and values that enable them to make positive physical, mental and spiritual health decisions, particularly about alcohol, drugs and sex.

### What is going on in SEOS?


As a result of the work that SEOS has either led or been a part of over the 2011/12 academic year, we've seen around 30 people respond to the gospel, supported the launch of 5 Alpha Courses, spoken to around 2500 students in 101 lectures and shared the gospel on multiple occasions.

We have also partnered with other organisations on school tour festivals, where we travel around

Estonia for an intensive week of lectures, concerts and gospel sharing activities.

We also provide training for other organisations.

SEOS, currently employs one full time project leader and two part time assistants, plus we have eight volunteer lecturers including church pastors, office workers and university students.


schools, help unwed mothers in crisis pregnancies, preach the Gospel, plant churches and bring the love of God to Estonians.
